Flutist Alicia "Lish" Lindsey made her Carnegie Hall debut as solo piccoloist with the Eastern Wind Symphony. She has performed at David Geffen Hall at Lincoln Center, Radio City Music Hall, Beacon Theatre, Central Park Summerstage, Barclays Center, Kennedy Center, Kimmel Center's Verizon Hall and Perelman Theater, and concert halls in Japan, China, Italy, England, and Wales.

Professional orchestral ensembles have included the South Florida, Harrisburg, Lancaster, and Reading Symphonies, Capital Philharmonic, Riverside Symphonia, Philadelphia Virtuosi, Strauss Symphony of America, Video Games Live Orchestra, Josh Groban's "Stages" and "On Stage" Tours, Il Volo "Grande Amore" and "Notte Magica" Tours, Rocktopia Live, Jerry Garcia Symphonic Celebration, and others. She made her Broadway debut as a substitute flutist in the musical Finding Neverland at the Lunt-Fontanne Theatre in NYC.
